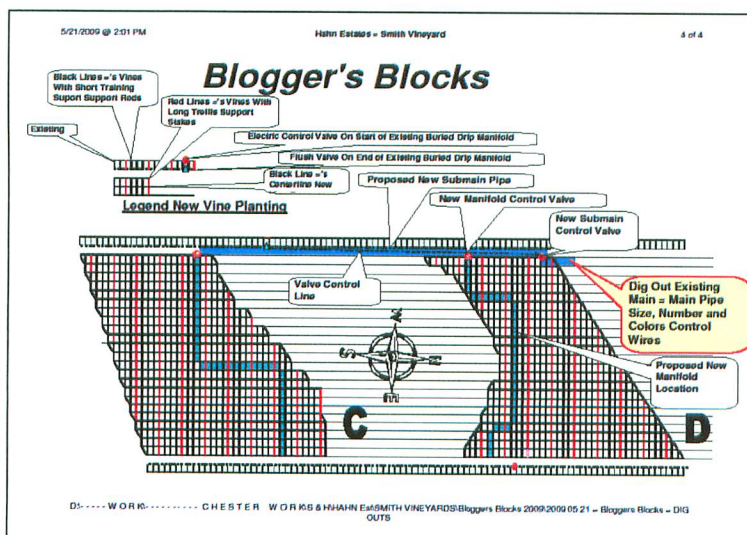

Parentage: riparia x rupestris

Vigor: low to moderate

Phylloxera resistance: high

Nematode resistance: low

Drought tolerance: low to medium

Wet soil: low to medium

Salinity: low to medium

Lime: low to medium

Ease of propagation: high

Other characteristics:

sensitive to latent viruses;

tolerant of cold damage
